2 nd	Manton	Burglary in Hostel	Offender stole cash from stables worker's room.
2 nd	Ogbourne St George	Criminal Damage	Offenders damaged children's play area.
3 rd	Savernake	Theft from motor vehicle	Offender smashed van window and stole a tax disc.
4 th	Mildenhall	Shed Break	Offender smashed lock and stole ride-on mower, . strimmer etc.
8 th	Savernake	Theft from motor vehicle	Offender jemmied open car boot and stole handbag
9 th	Manton	Theft from motor vehicle	Offender smashed car window and stole handbag
10 th	Ogbourne St George	Criminal Damage	The mirror was ripped off parked car in the High St
12 th	Savernake	Office theft	Offender took purse from hospital office.
14 th	West Overton	Offensive texts	Offender sent offensive texts to resident
14 th	Ogbourne St George	Burglary, empty premises	While the occupants were away for a few days, . offenders broke in and stole TV
15 th	Winterbourne Monkton	Hare Coursing	Offenders were arrested trespassing in formation. across fields with hunting dogs
22 nd	Mildenhall	Burglary, occupied house	Offender stole handbag from just inside unlocked . kitchen door in broad daylight
23 rd	Manton	Criminal Damage	Offenders smashed exterior of locked caravan

Please note that the purse thief went into Marlborough immediately and tried to use the victim's cashpoint machine. The thief was unsuccessful because the offender did not find out the victim's PIN number.
