At this service we will remember those who have died and give thanks to God for all that they have meant and continue to mean to us.

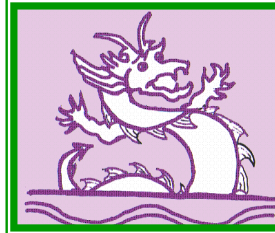
