We meet on average five times a year, and there is a small amount of administrative work between the meetings.

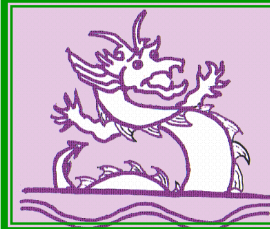
This is a voluntary post. If you feel you might be able to help us please contact Fr Roger, Nicky Irwin or Lesley Ayres.
