Please be more careful with your dogs, and keep to the footpaths.

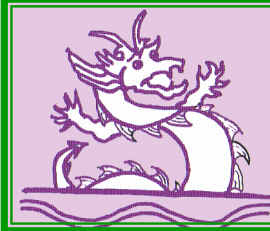
