Please drop off at the plant stall (outside Carol's - opposite Pooles Meadow)

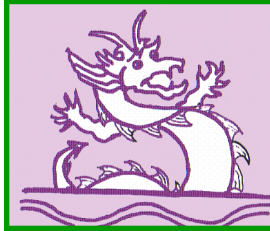

After careful consideration, the governors made the decision to move our school from local authority control. This was a decision we made of our own volition. We wanted the benefits of autonomy as well as the benefits of linking formally with other local schools as part of the Excalibur Multi-Agency Trust. We're now looking forward to extending our work on developing an 'all-through' curriculum with St John's Marlborough and the other schools in the trust, so that our children benefit from a unified approach to education as they move from primary into secondary education.

However, we are still keen to retain our own individuality and identity as a small, caring Church of England village school.

Therefore we've retained the term 'school' as part of our new name: Ogbourne C of E Primary School.

We've taken this bold step, moving away from Wiltshire Council control, and we're now excited about working closely with the other schools and enjoying the opportunities that collaboration can offer to both children and staff.
