Did you know...?

Sometimes, particularly when the surgery is closed, it can be difficult to decide which of the many services on offer is best for your situation.

If you call **111**, a free national phone number, you will receive advice at any time on where and how to receive the most appropriate treatment for urgent medical needs that are not emergencies.

The NHS 111 service is staffed by a team of fully trained advisers, supported by experienced nurses and paramedics. They will ask questions to assess your symptoms, then give you the healthcare advice you need or direct you straightaway to the local service that can help you best, which could include an out-of-hours doctor, an emergency dentist or late-opening dentist.

Where possible the NHS 111 team will book you an appointment or transfer you directly to the people you need to speak to. If NHS 111 advisers think you need an ambulance, they will immediately arrange for one to be sent to you.

For immediate, life-threatening emergencies, such as loss of consciousness, acute confused state and fits that are not stopping, persistent severe chest pain, breathing difficulties, severe bleeding that cannot be stopped, severe allergic reactions, severe burns or scalds call 999.
