In Ogbourne St George we offer a number of different services styles, all are welcome to attend any service and to join in when it feels right, or sometimes it might feel more comfortable to sit and listen. Children are also welcome at all services, we have some children's activities in church (toys and colouring) as we know (from our own experiences that it can seem quite a long time to sit still). The more traditional services have been identified to help those who prefer this style of worship.

We know it's not always obvious what's happening or when, here is a quick translation of the different services:

- o Café Church (10am: 1st Sunday each month)– An informal (family friendly) service with hymns, and discussion over coffee and cake!
- o Holy Communion (8:30am: 2nd Sunday) – A traditional service from the Book of Common Prayer (without hymns).
- o Parish Communion (9:30am: 3rd Sunday) – A (family friendly) service with the opportunity to take communion or have a blessing.
- o Morning Prayer/Worship (9:30am: 4th Sunday) (November - March) – A traditional service with psalms and hymns.
- o Evensong (6pm: 4th Sunday) (from April to October) – A traditional service with psalms and hymns.
