



Grants from £1,000-£4,000 are available. The grant system is permanently open and groups can apply at any time as there is no cut off period.

18. WILTSHIRE COUNCIL ELECTRONIC CONSULTATIONS

To receive the notification from Wiltshire Council concerning the introduction of Electronic Planning Consultations.

From 31 July 2017 all applications for consultation will be sent electronically on the day of registration, with a link to the website, to enable viewing the documents on the day the application is registered. This will give councillors longer to comment (likely to be around 28 days rather than the current 21 days). This will also give better access to the plans without waiting for circulation of the hard copies.
